

## MILTON TOWNSHIP ANNUAL MEETING

Tuesday, April 13, 2021

The Annual Meeting of Milton Township, County of DuPage was held at the Wheaton Park District Community Center, Wheaton, Illinois, on April 13, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. There was one guest; and thirty-three electors, including six Township elected officials. The elected officials in attendance were: Supervisor O. Chris Heidorn, Town Clerk Gail P. Hinkle, Highway Commissioner Gary Muehlfelt, and Trustees Yadav Nathwani, David Molitor and John Monino.

The meeting was called to order by Clerk Hinkle at 7:00 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mr. Chris Heidorn.

Clerk Hinkle introduced the elected officials.

Trustee David Molitor thanked three persons who were involved with the Township Government. Mr. Molitor thanked Chris Heidorn for his services as Supervisor of the Township for nineteen years. Trustee Molitor thanked Gail Hinkle for her dedicated years serving the Township for twenty-two years. Mr. Ralph Hinkle was introduced as creating the CERT Program for Milton Township.

The first order of business was a call by the Clerk for the nominations of a Moderator for the Annual Meeting. Chuck Smith of Wheaton nominated Chris Heidorn to serve as Moderator. Marty Keller of Wheaton seconded the nomination. No other nominations were presented and the nominations were closed on the motion of Marie Jensen of Wheaton, seconded by Dan Milinko of Wheaton. Mr. Heidorn was unanimously elected Moderator by voice vote.

Clerk Hinkle administered the Oath of Moderator to Mr. Heidorn who then conducted the meeting.

Mr. Heidorn welcomed everyone to the 171<sup>st</sup> Annual Township Meeting. Mr. Heidorn introduced himself as the Parliamentarian and Lance P. Hinkle as the Sergeant-at-arms for tonight's meeting.

Mr. Heidorn stated that as required by law, the Township Board approve the Agenda as presented at the March 10, 2021 Township Meeting. Copies of the Agenda and copies of the Minutes for the April 21, 2020 Annual Meeting are made available for all attendees of this meeting.

Cathy Keller of Wheaton moved, seconded by Joe Soto of Wheaton, to dispense with the reading of the Minutes and to approve the Minutes of April 21, 2020. The motion carried by voice vote.

Mr. Heidorn announced the dispensing of the reading of the Supervisor's Annual Statement that was issued to each attendee of this meeting.

Mr. Heidorn announced, as Supervisor of Milton Township, he has had the honor to have served the longest term than any other Township Supervisor. Accomplishments made under the supervision of Mr. Heidorn includes the creation of (CERT), the Emergency Response Team, led by Ralph Hinkle in 2004. Under Heidorn's leadership, we have seen more tax abatements and greater amount of tax abatements than any other Township in DuPage County and possibly the State of Illinois. Another accomplishment

was incorporating the Milton Township Food Pantry, as an Illinois non-profit corporation, recognized by the Internal Revenue Service 501 (C) (3) charitable organization, with the help of Dave and Arlene DeMotte. The Township Food Pantry has over \$80,000 in their bank fund. The Food Pantry is operated only through donations. No tax dollars involved. Mr. Heidorn complimented his staff on serving the public well.

The next order of business was the consideration of the proposed Resolutions. A written explanation of the purpose of each Resolution was presented along with written copies of the proposed Resolutions. Jeff Castle of Glen Ellyn moved, seconded by Chuck Smith of Wheaton, to dispense with the reading of the Resolutions. The motion passed by voice vote.

Marty Keller of Wheaton moved, seconded by Cathy Keller of Wheaton, to approve as presented the Resolution entitled, "Authorizing certain Powers to the Township Board". The motion passed by voice vote. The Resolution is attached and made a part of these minutes.

Joe Soto of Wheaton moved, seconded by Jeff Castle of Glen Ellyn, to approve as presented the Resolution entitled, "Fixing Hour for Township Meetings". The motion passed by voice vote. The Resolution is attached and made a part of these minutes.

Open Forum – Ralph Hinkle of Wheaton, commented on Mr. Heidorn's accomplishments as Supervisor. The remodeling and rehabbing of the Township building that came in under budget, and within the time frame.

There being no further business to come before the electors, the meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m. upon the motion of Marty Keller of Wheaton, seconded by Dan Milinko of Wheaton. The motion carried by voice vote.
