

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MILTON TOWNSHIP BOARD

July 11, 2006

A Regular Meeting of the Milton Township Board was held in the Board Room of the Milton Town-Hall, 1492 N. Main Street, Wheaton, Illinois, on Tuesday, July 11, 2006, for the audit of town bills followed immediately by a business meeting.

Board Members Present: Supervisor O. Chris Heidorn - Clerk A. Arlene DeMotte - Trustees James D. Flickinger, Sal Falbo, Robert L. Larsen, and Leonard Sanchez. Board Members Absent: None. Other Elected Officials Present: Assessor Robert Earl and Highway Commissioner Gary Muehlfelt. Also Present: Bob Jacobsen, Bill Kooser, Ken McNatt, and Ralph Hinkle.

The business meeting was called to order by Chairman Heidorn at 7:30 p.m. Gary Muehlfelt led the Pledge of Allegiance. A quorum was present and acting, and due notice had been mailed.

Trustee Flickinger moved, seconded by Trustee Larsen, to approve the agenda as presented. The motion passed by voice vote.

Trustee Falbo moved, seconded by Trustee Sanchez, that the minutes of the Regular Meeting on June 13, 2006, be approved as submitted. The motion passed by voice vote.

Having concluded their audit of the Township bills in the earlier segment of the meeting, Trustee Sanchez moved, seconded by Trustee Flickinger, that the bills having been audited be paid and charged to the proper accounts, and the certificates of accounts be filed by the Clerk for inspection by the inhabitants of the Township. Following discussion, the motion passed on the following roll-call vote: 5 Ayes: Trustees Flickinger, Falbo, Larsen, Sanchez, and Chairman Heidorn. 0 Nays.

Public Forum Comments - None.

Chairman's Report:

- General Assistance/Food Pantry - A written report of the General Assistance Department activities was distributed to the Board. Chairman Heidorn reported that the Food Pantry is stocked but the inventory is diminishing. He also reported that he had served on the DuPage County General Assistance Appeal Committee last month.
- Citizen Corps/Homeland Security - Ralph Hinkle reported that the CERT team had a float in the July 4th Parade and that two citizens volunteered for the program after seeing the float.
- Mosquito Abatement/WNV - The bill from Clark Environmental for mosquito abatement was included with tonight's bills.
- Weeds - Chairman Heidorn has asked Ralph Hinkle to handle the Weed Program since he hasn't been able to do so himself because of his recent surgery. Mr. Hinkle reported that he is looking for a contractor to do the weed cutting. The Board briefly discussed revising the Weed Program.
- Miscellaneous - Chairman Heidorn distributed information to the Trustees from the Township Officials of Illinois regarding finances and training for Trustees.

Highway Commissioner Muehlfelt updated the Board on the Highway Department's activities during the past 30 days including trimming of trees and removal of trees along township roads. A written report was given to the Board members.

Assessor Earl reported that the assessing field work is done.

Clerk DeMotte did not have a report nor did the Committee on Youth.

S.A.L.T. Chairman McNatt reported on the Committee's meeting yesterday with a speaker on senior home sharing. There will not be a meeting in August. The newsletter is being printed now. The Committee is seeking grants and other methods of raising money for Committee expenses.

Cemeteries Authority - Authority Chairman Jacobsen reported that Dutch Elm Disease was found at the Champion Forest site resulting in about ten trees being cut down with the help of the Highway Department.

Unfinished Business - None.

New Business - None.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Trustee Flickinger moved, seconded by Trustee Sanchez, that the meeting stand adjourned. The motion carried by voice vote, and the meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
