

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MILTON TOWNSHIP BOARD

June 12, 2018

A Regular Meeting of the Milton Township Board was held in the Board Room of the Milton Town Hall, 1492 N. Main Street, Wheaton, Illinois, on Tuesday, June 12, 2018, for the audit of town bills followed immediately by a business meeting.

Board Members Present: Supervisor O. Chris Heidorn - Clerk Gail P. Hinkle - Trustees Sal Falbo, Yadav Nathwani, David Molitor, and John Monino. Also Present: Ed Klich, Chuck Smith, Trent Tiber and Tommy Tiber.

The business meeting was called to order by Chairman Heidorn at 6:30 p.m. Gail Hinkle led the Pledge of Allegiance. A quorum was present and acting, and due notice had been mailed in compliance with the Open Meetings Act.

Trustee Molitor moved, seconded by Trustee Nathwani, to approve the agenda as presented. The motion passed by voice vote.

Trustee Molitor moved, seconded by Trustee Monino, that the minutes of the Regular Meeting on May 8, 2018, be approved as submitted. The motion passed by voice vote.

Having concluded their audit of the Township bills in the earlier segment of the meeting, Chairman Heidorn moved, seconded by Trustee Molitor that the bills having been audited be paid and charged to the proper accounts, and the certificates of accounts be filed by the Clerk for inspection by the inhabitants of the Township. Following discussion, the motion passed on the following roll-call vote: Trustees Falbo, Nathwani, Molitor, Monino and Chairman Heidorn. (5 Ayes), (0 Nays).

Public Forum – Mr. Edward Klich, a resident of unincorporated Glen Ellyn, expressed to the Board, his concern of an ongoing problem with standing water on his front lawn at the roadway swale. Chairman Heidorn commented this issue is between Mr. Klich and the Milton Township Highway Commissioner. Discussion followed. Trent and Tommy Tiber are attending the Milton Township Board meeting this evening in order to earn their merit badge from the Boy Scout Troop.

Chairman's Report:

- General Assistance/Food Pantry – The Board was issued the monthly General Assistance report for the month of May. GOP volunteers collected over \$500.00 for the Food Pantry while attending the Taste of Glen Ellyn and the Wheaton French Market. Discussion followed.
- Weed Ordinance Enforcement – Due to the heavy rains, the weed enforcement is in full swing. Ronna Johnson, an employee of the Township, has been assisting Mr. Heidorn on the many weed complaints. Discussion followed.
- Audit progress report – Auditor, Andy Miriani, is in the process of completing the Township's audit.
- Miscellaneous/Other – One of the Township's Special Police Officers is being reassigned to a different Department. A replacement will be announced soon.

Penni Cannova, Milton Township Deputy Clerk & Senior Services Coordinator is looking into possibly editing a Milton Township Newsletter. Mr. Heidorn has suggested placing a small write-up on Township Government in the S.A.L.T. Communicator. Discussion followed.

Mr. Heidorn received a letter from Mr. Rob Weinberg, a resident of Winfield, IL. Mr. Weinberg expressed his concern about the pesticide, Roundup, being used in public places. Mr. Heidorn stated that Roundup is not a pesticide but an herbicide. Milton Township uses only pesticides for the Mosquito Abatement District. Mr. Heidorn will reply to Mr. Weinberg's letter. Discussion followed.

Cemeteries Authority –

Mr. Heidorn presented to the Board a copy of an Invitation to Patriotism and Family Day at the Pleasant Hill Cemetery, June 30, 2018 at 11:00 am. Mr. Jacobsen has hired two machinists/blacksmiths from Indiana to work on the Cooley plot iron fence. Mr. Heidorn obtained a copy of the original plat of the Jewell Grove Cemetery. Discussion followed.

Trustees – Trustee Nathwani reported on the Postal Food Drive. John Monino, Marty Keller and Yadav Nathwani helped sort the food at the Township Office.

New Business –

Prevailing Wage Ordinances –No. O-18-3 and No. HW O-18-3

Trustee Molitor moved, seconded by Trustee Monino to adopt Ordinance No. O-18-3 entitled "*An Ordinance Of Milton Township, County Of DuPage, Illinois, Ascertainig The Prevailing Rate Of Wages for Laborer's, Workmen, and Mechanics Employed On Public Works Of Milton Township*" and, Ordinance No. HW-O-18-3 entitled "*An Ordinance Of The Milton Township Road District, County Of DuPage, Illinois, Ascertainig The Prevailing Rate Of Wages For Laborers, Workmen, And Mechanics Employed On Public Works Of Milton Township*". The motion passed by voice vote.

Miscellaneous/Other – None.

Seniors Committee – Chairman Chuck Smith discussed the recent S.A.L.T. Meeting held on June 11, 2108. Guest speakers, Matt Binder, from the Wheaton Public Library and Sarah Kleiva, from the Glen Ellyn Library, discussed the various free library programs that are offered to the public.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Trustee Molitor moved, seconded by Trustee Nathwani that the meeting stand adjourned. The motion carried by voice vote, and the meeting adjourned at 7:21p.m.
