ORDINANCE NO. 89-3

PROHIBITION ON PARKING OF VEHICLES

AN ORDINANCE ON THE PROHIBITION ON PARKING OF VEHICLES ON MILTON TOWNSHIP ROADS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MILTON TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1 - Prohibited Parking: No motor vehicle shall be permitted to park in the road right-of-way of any posted Township road. This prohibition shall take effect on Township roads upon posting of individual locations by the Township. This prohibition shall take effect on Township roads upon the approval of the County Superintendent of Highways and posting in accordance with § 23-52.

Section 2 - Road Right-of-Way: "Road right-of-way," as used in this Section, means that area, including the paved road surface, road shoulder and that area which extends to and/or abuts private property.

Section 3 - Posting of Signs: Signs giving notice of the parking prohibition shall conform to the "Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices." Said signs shall be erected by the local highway authority having maintenance jurisdiction over the roads on which the signs are to be posted. The signs shall be located upon such roadways in a clearly marked and visible manner.

Section 4 - Enforcement - Ticketing and Towing: The Township Enforcement Officer shall enforce the provisions of this Ordinance and issue a ticket for any violation thereof. In addition to the issuance of a ticket, the Township Enforcement Officer may authorize the removal or towing of such vehicles under the towing provisions of **Illinois Revised Statutes, Ch. 95½, ¶¶ 4-201 through 4-214.**


Section 5 - Penalties:

(a) Fine: Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) if paid within ten (10) days from the date of issuance of the ticket or, thereafter, the fine shall be Thirty Dollars (\$30.00). If the fine remains unpaid within ten (10) days of the second notice, the fine will be escalated to Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and the matter turned over to a collection agency or will be sent to the DuPage County Court for further collection proceedings.

(b) Settling Claims: Any person accused of a violation of this Ordinance may settle and compromise the claim by paying to the Township the sum of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) within ten (10) days from the time such alleged offense was committed.


(c) Collection: The tickets under this Section shall be issued in lieu of arrest. If the person accused of the violation fails to settle the claim, a complaint or notice to appear will be issued for that violation, and the person shall be subject to criminal prosecution as set forth in the Code.
