Resolution No. R-11-7

A Resolution of the Township of Milton, County of DuPage, Illinois

Relating to Participation by Elected Officials in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund

WHEREAS, Milton Township is a participant in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund; and

WHEREAS, elected officials may participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund if they are in positions normally requiring performance of duty for 1,000 hours or more per year; and

WHEREAS, this governing body can determine what the normal annual hourly requirements of its elected officials are, and should make such determination for the guidance and direction of the Board of Trustees of the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund (IMRF);

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MILTON TOWNSHIP BOARD duly assembled at a Regular Board Meeting finds that effective January 1, 2011, the position of Milton Township Trustee no longer qualifies for membership in IMRF.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE MILTON TOWNSHIP BOARD that the positions of Township Supervisor, Township Clerk, Township Assessor and Township Highway Commissioner remain unchanged, requiring over 1,000 hours of duty per year and continue to qualify for membership in IMRF.
