A Resolution of the Township of Milton, County of DuPage, Illinois

Regarding Rules Governing Recording of Meetings by the Public

WHEREAS, Section 2.05 of the Illinois Open Meetings Act (5 ILCS 120/2/05) provides in pertinent part that ... any person may record the proceedings at meetings required to be open by this Act by tape, film or other means. The authority holding the meeting shall prescribe reasonable rules to govern the right to make such recording; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board is the authority holding such meetings; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the Board prescribe reasonable rules governing the recording of the Board's open meetings by members of the public.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MILTON TOWNSHIP BOARD duly assembled at a Regular Board Meeting as follows:

- 1. **Open Meeting Recording Guidelines**: The Open Meeting Recording Guidelines attached hereto are hereby adopted. The Township Supervisor, in his sole discretion, may from time to time revise these Guidelines so long as he provides copies to the Board Members at least one week before the effective date of the revisions.
- 2. **Posting Requirement**: A copy of the Guidelines currently in effect shall be permanently posted on the Township bulletin board at the Township Offices.
- 3. Effective Date: This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.
