LOCAL GOVERNMENT -- WORKING FOR YOU

Township Government, as it now exists in DuPage County and most of northern Illinois, is an evolution of the governmental form transplanted to this area by the earliest settlers who began arriving about 1830 from the northeastern United States. DuPage County was organized into nine townships in 1850. Milton Township is in the exact center of DuPage County.

When you add Wheaton and Glen Ellyn to nearby unincorporated areas and then tack on a fraction of Carol Stream, Lombard, and Winfield, you have a population of 117,322 people and a 36 square mile land area called **MILTON TOWNSHIP**.

SUMMARY OF PURPOSE:

- To provide emergency assistance to the needy persons of the Township.
- To maintain Township roads
- To establish the valuation of real estate and other property as the basis for assessing taxes for all taxing units within the Township.
- To maintain records of the Township.
