ACCEPTANCE OF FUNCTIONS AND JURISDICTION OF THE GLEN ELLYN MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2019, by Public Act 100-0793 (codified at 70 Illinois Compiled Statutes 1005, Sec.11.5) the Illinois legislature has provided a mechanism whereby an existing mosquito abatement district may elect to consolidate that district into the township in which the district sits; and

WHEREAS, the Glen Ellyn Mosquito Abatement District sits within Milton Township; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to statute, the Trustees of the Glen Ellyn Mosquito Abatement District have by majority vote approved a proposition to consolidate the Glen Ellyn Mosquito Abatement District into Milton Township; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees of Milton Township, after due consideration of the question, have determined that the public interest in the health, welfare, safety and comfort of all residents of the Township is best served by administering mosquito abatement in the Township in a more comprehensive and coordinated manner; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees of Milton Township, have determined that that goal is best served by accepting the functions and jurisdiction of the Glen Ellyn Mosquito Abatement District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Milton Township Board that Milton Township hereby accepts the functions and jurisdiction of the Glen Ellyn Mosquito Abatement District, including but not limited to all the rights, powers, duties, assets, property, liabilities, indebtedness, obligations, bonding authority, taxing authority, and responsibilities of the district.

FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this Resolution to be filed with the DuPage County Clerk.
