A RESOLUTION OF MILTON TOWNSHIP, DuPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS
RECOGNIZING THE IMPORTANCE OF THE 2010 DECENNIAL CENSUS

WHEREAS, Census information is used to determine how many members our State has in the United States House of Representatives and is also used to determine districts in our State legislature and local governing bodies, AND,

WHEREAS, having an accurate and complete Census count is important to our community in determining Federal and State aid and grants, economic development, housing assistance, transportation, and many other uses, AND,

WHEREAS, every resident in our community counts and deserves to be counted,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees of Milton Township, DuPage County, Illinois recognizes the importance of the 2010 Census and agrees to form a Complete Count Committee and to promote the Census to assure that all residents of our community are counted.
