TAX LEVY ORDINANCE

An ordinance levying taxes for all road purposes for the Milton Township Road District, DuPage County, Illinois, for the tax year 2011, collectable in 2012.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of Milton Township, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Highway Commissioner of Milton Township Road District on December 13, 2011, does hereby determine and declare that the sum of **Three Million Seventy One Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Seven and 20/100 Dollars (\$3,071,387.20)** is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Road District as that property is assessed and equalized, in order to meet and defray all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Road District as required by statute or voted by the people in accordance with the law, for such purposes as:

The General Road Fund

for the year 2011.

SECTION 2: That the amount levied for each object and purpose shall be as follows:

SECTION 4: That the Board of Trustees does hereby certify that the amount levied herein is necessary to be raised for taxation for road purposes for the Milton Township Road District.

SECTION 5: That if any section, subdivision, or sentence of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such finding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.


SECTION 6: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption as provided by law.


