

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MILTON TOWNSHIP BOARD

January 10, 2023

A Regular Meeting for the Milton Township Board was held in the Board Room of the Milton Town Hall, 1492 N. Main Street, Wheaton Illinois, on Tuesday, January 10, 2023.

Board Members Present: Chairman John Monino, Clerk Yadav "Nick" Nathwani, Trustees, Jeff Castle, Drew Ellis, Dan Milinko, and Joe Soto. Guests Signed in: Marty Keller, Chuck Smith, and Paula McGowan.

The business meeting was called to order by Chairman Monino at 6:30 P.M. Bill led the Pledge of Allegiance. A quorum was present and acting and due notice had been posted in compliance with the Open Meetings Act.

Trustee Ellis, seconded by Trustee Soto, to approve the agenda as presented. On voice vote, all those present voted aye. The motion passed.

Trustee Castle moved, seconded by Trustee Soto, to approve the minutes from the Regular meeting December 13, 2022. On a voice vote, all those present voted aye. The motion passed.

Having concluded the audit of the Township bills in the earlier segment of the meeting, Trustee Ellis moved, seconded by Trustee Soto that the bills be approved after been audited be paid and charged to the proper accounts, and certificates of accounts be filed by the Clerk for inspection by the citizens of the Township. Following discussion, on a roll call vote: Trustee Castle, Ellis, Milinko, Soto, and Chairman Monino. The motion passed.

Public Forum

Chairman's Report:

- 708 Board Service Contracts Award – Supervisor Monino informed the board that the 708 Board hosted meet and greet before the business meeting. The meet and greet included the 708 board and grant recipients.
- General Assistance Dept & Food Pantry – Supervisor Monino passed out a report on general assistance and the food pantry dated November 2022. He motioned that now that the township accepts LIHEAP applications, and that residents in the community are using the township to apply for LIHEAP.
- Cemeteries – Supervisor Monino informed the board that Dennis Choyeski will retire from his duties as landscaper of the township cemeteries. The township will look for a new landscaper.
- Budget Workshop Dates – Trustee Milinko proposed a budget workshop for the board in February. He mentioned that he would like around 2 hours of everyone time to go through the numbers.
- Newsletter for Milton April & September – Supervisor Monino informed that board that the township will send out newsletters twice a year. He informed all the department heads of this change.
- Misc./Other- None.

Officials & Committee Reports:

- A. Town Clerk – Clerk Nathwani mentioned that he and Andrew are working together to plan a successful Annual Meeting in April 2023. Also, his office is in compliance with the DuPage County Clerk in submitting a list of names from Milton, that will be required to fill out a Statement of Economic Interest. Clerk Nathwani mentioned that the portal for filers will open March 1, 2023.
- B. Seniors Committee – Chuck Smith mentioned that SALT hosted a successful meeting in January 2023. The meeting had 21 attendees. The last meeting hosted a service

organization which presented their capabilities and how they serve the community. Chuck also mentioned that the new SALT communicator should hit mailboxes very soon. Finally, the Senior Committee continues to help seniors in the community address financial issues.

- C. Cemeteries Authority – Chairman Monino mentioned that he is working with Trustee Ellis for dates in 2023 for events. This year, they are going to try scheduling these events before a national holiday to see if that helps increase attendance.

- A. Capital Projects – Supervisor Monino informed that board that he would liked to have a meeting dedicated to planning for a future building. He shared that his goal is to build a campus for the township. The campus could be funded through grants. Recently, the township received a \$55,000 grant from Senator Glowjack.


