

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MILTON TOWNSHIP BOARD

April 18, 2023

A Regular Meeting for the Milton Township Board was held in the Board Room of the Milton Town Hall, 1492 N. Main Street, Wheaton Illinois, on Tuesday, April 18, 2023.

Board Members Present: Chairman John Monino, Clerk Yadav "Nick" Nathwani, Trustees, Jeff Castle, Drew Ellis, Joe Soto, and Dan Milinko.

The business meeting was called to order by Chairman Monino at 6:30 P.M. Dave Sezonov led the Pledge of Allegiance. A quorum was present and acting and due notice had been posted in compliance with the Open Meetings Act.

Trustee Castle, seconded by Trustee Ellis, to approve the agenda as presented. On voice vote, all those present voted aye. The motion passed.

Trustee Castle moved, seconded by Trustee Ellis to approve the minutes from the Regular and Special meeting from March 14, 2023 and March 28, 2023. On a voice vote, all those present voted aye. The motion passed.

Having concluded the audit of the Township bills in the earlier segment of the meeting, Trustee Castle moved, seconded by Trustee Soto that the bills be approved after been audited be paid and charged to the proper accounts, and certificates of accounts be filed by the Clerk for inspection by the citizens of the Township. Following discussion, on a roll call vote: Trustee Castle, Ellis, Milinko, Soto, and Chairman Monino. The motion passed.

Public Forum

Chairman's Report:

- A. General Assistance Department – Chairman Monino mentioned that data presented to him indicates that the township GA department is seeing more members of the community. Also, Ronna has recently improved the process to apply for LIHEAP.
- B. Food Pantry – Chairman Monino updated the board on the food pantry's progress. Recently, the food pantry refrigerators and freezers installed. The township will be hosting a open house. Also the township received a \$3,000 donation from Carol Stream and Mayor Frank Savarino. Also, an anonymous individual donated \$1,200 worth of garments for veterans.
- C. Audit to start – Chairman Monino announced that the bid to be the township will go to RFP as directed by the board.
- D. Township Board to Review Sidewalk on Butterfield – Supervisor Monion and Commissioner Muehlfelt recently visited the sidewalk along Butterfield Road.
- E. Appointment of Citizens to Decennial Committee – Chairman Monino announced that he has found 2 members to serve on the township's Decennial Committee, Donna Kemp and Mike Harvey. The board may approve their applications next month.
- F. Misc/Other - None

Officials & Committee Reports:

- A. Town Clerk – Clerk Nathwani mentioned that everyone Statement of Economic interest is due by May 1, 2023. He has reminded all elected officials and office staff. Clerk Nathwani also announced that the board held a successful annual town meeting.
- B. CERT – Chairman Monino mentioned that CERT recently graduated a new class. A new CERT class will be held in August. Also, the team is setting their schedule for events this summer.
- C. SALT – None.

- D. Cemeteries Authority – Trustee Castle announced that he will be starting a vegetable garden at St Stephen Cemetery. Also, he is in the process of requesting bids to fix the fence at Pleasant Hill.
- E. Food Pantry – Dave Sezonov thanked the board for their continued support for him and the food pantry. Dave said that the new fridge and freezer are working well.
- F. Weed Program – Chairman Monino mentioned that he had on complaint at a house that has been abandoned for 12 years. The township gave the homeowner 15 days to fix the issue.
- G. Trustee – Trustee Milinko recognized Trustee Castle for his leadership in TOI. He was recently appointed to TOI's board. Trustee Castle also mentioned that vegetables grown at the St Stephen Garden can be used in the food pantry. He will be seeking volunteers to tend the garden.

Unfinished Business

- A. Completion of Budget – Chairman Monino announced that the budget was approved last month.

New Business


- A. Highway Commissioner Annual Report to the Board – Supervisor Monino handed out the Highway Commissioner's annual report to the board.
