

REGULAR MEETING OF THE MILTON TOWNSHIP BOARD

June 13, 2023

A Regular Meeting for the Milton Township Board was held in the Board Room of the Milton Town Hall, 1492 N. Main Street, Wheaton Illinois, on Tuesday, June 13, 2023.

Board Members Present: Chairman John Monino, Clerk Yadav "Nick" Nathwani, Trustees, Jeff Castle, Drew Ellis, Joe Soto, and Dan Milinko.

The business meeting was called to order by Chairman Monino at 6:30 P.M. Chuck Smith led the Pledge of Allegiance. A quorum was present and acting and due notice had been posted in compliance with the Open Meetings Act.

Trustee Soto, seconded by Trustee Ellis, to approve the agenda as presented. On voice vote, all those present voted aye. The motion passed.

Trustee Ellis moved, seconded by Trustee Soto to approve the minutes from the Regular meeting from May 16, 2023. On a voice vote, all those present voted aye. The motion passed.

Having concluded the audit of the Township bills in the earlier segment of the meeting, Trustee Castle moved, seconded by Trustee Milinko that the bills be approved after been audited be paid and charged to the proper accounts, and certificates of accounts be filed by the Clerk for inspection by the citizens of the Township. Following discussion, on a roll call vote: Trustee Castle, Ellis, Milinko, Soto, and Chairman Monino. The motion passed.

Public Forum

- A. Amy Goodman mentioned that she and her family and extremely happy with the township and highway department. She is proud to say she resides in Milton Township.

Chairman's Report:

- A. General Assistance Department – Chairman Monino announced that the township has been more diligent and throughout to see who qualifies for general assistance. As a result, they have found several cases of fraud. Last month, 23 applicants were ineligible.
- B. 708 Board Meeting – Chairman Monino mentioned that he met with other townships and explained how the 708 boards process and mission. Also, the 708 Board is looking into a community psychiatrist.
- C. Sexual Harassment Training – Chairman Monino announced that the town side in cooperating with the highway department completed sexual harassment training.
- D. Milton Township Garden – Chairman Monino mentioned that the garden was in full bloom. The garden should be ready to donate produce to the food pantry later this year.
- E. Cream of Wheaton – Chairman Monino mentioned the township had a booth at the Cream of Wheaton. He thanked all the volunteers.
- F. Milton/Wheaton Park District Event – Chairman Monino announced that Milton Township and the Wheaton Park District will hold a joint event on Saturday, June 24th. Proceeds from the event will benefit the Milton Township food pantry.
- G. Misc/Other - None

Officials & Committee Reports:

- A. Town Clerk – Clerk Nathwani mentioned that his number received 2 FOIA's since the last meeting. Both FOIA's were completed within 5 business days.
- B. CERT – No Report.
- C. Food Pantry – Dave mentioned that all of the renovations completed, and thankd the board for their support. Dave reminded the Board that the State of Illinois will start taxing food July 1, 2023. Also, Bags for Life donated over \$3,000 to the township food pantry.

- D. SALT – Chuck Smith reported that the last SALT meeting had 29 attendees and 5 police officers. The DuPage County Sheriff sent a new liaison to the meeting as well. Also, Jodi Hefler a longtime supporter of SALT will be moving on to a new opportunity.
- E. Cemeteries Authority – Chairman Monino announced that the next cemeteries event will be Saturday, June 24th at Pleasant Hill Cemetery.
- F. Trustee – Trustee Milinko gave a special mention to the township CERT team for their efforts at the Cream of Wheaton. Trustee Castle mentioned that he donated his township stipend last month to a family who needed to buy a wheelchair for their son. Also, during the Cream of Wheaton, Jeff educated individuals on how the township could help them.

Unfinished Business

- A. Audit Wrap Up – Chairman Monino mentioned that the audit is almost complete.


New Business
