

## REGULAR MEETING OF THE MILTON TOWNSHIP BOARD

October 10, 2023

A Regular Meeting for the Milton Township Board was held in the Board Room of the Milton Town Hall, 1492 N. Main Street, Wheaton Illinois, on Tuesday, October 10, 2023

Board Members Present: Chairman John Monino, Clerk Yadav "Nick" Nathwani, Trustees, Jeff Castle, Drew Ellis, Joe Soto, and Dan Milinko.

The business meeting was called to order by Chairman Monino at 6:30 P.M. Dave S. led the Pledge of Allegiance. A quorum was present and acting and due notice had been posted in compliance with the Open Meetings Act.

Trustee Soto, seconded by Trustee Milinko, to approve the agenda as presented. On voice vote, all those present voted aye. The motion passed.

Trustee Soto moved, seconded by Trustee Ellis to approve the minutes from the Regular meetings from September 12, 2023. On a voice vote, all those present voted aye. The motion passed.

Having concluded the audit of the Township bills in the earlier segment of the meeting, Trustee Ellis moved, seconded by Trustee Soto that the bills be approved after been audited be paid and charged to the proper accounts, and certificates of accounts be filed by the Clerk for inspection by the citizens of the Township. Following discussion, on a roll call vote: Trustee Castle, Ellis, Milinko, Soto, and Chairman Monino. The motion passed.

- A. General Assistance Department – Chairman Monino mentioned the township is accepting LIHEAP applications. As of the day of the meeting, the township has accepted 145 applications.

- C. Seniors Luncheon Thanksgiving/Christmas – Chairman Monino announced that the township is organizing a senior event. They plan on inviting over 100 seniors in Milton Township. The township will also sponsor a Christmas event.
- D. Stumm Insurance – Open Enrollment – Chairman Monino announced that now is the time for employees who aren't on the township health insurance plan to sign up. Stumm has visited the township and highway department to answer any questions.
