

MILTON TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. R-23-07

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MILTON TOWNSHIP,  
DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS PROVIDING FOR AND REQUIRING THE  
SUBMISSION OF A PUBLIC QUESTION TO ALLOW FOR TOWNSHIP AUTHORITY  
TO CONTRACT FOR THE DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE, REFUSE AND RECYCLING  
TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS OF THE TOWNSHIP AT THE GENERAL  
PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 19, 2024**

WHEREAS, the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/210-5 *et seq.*, grants Township Boards the authority to make contracts with any city, village, or incorporated town or with any person, corporation, or county for more than one year and not more than 15 years relating to the composting or recycling of garbage, refuse, and ashes within the unincorporated areas of the township or (ii) relating to the collection and final disposition, or relating solely to either the collection or the final disposition, of garbage, refuse, and ashes within the unincorporated area of the township; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor and Board of Trustees ("Board") of Milton Township ("Township") are authorized to enter into such a contract for its unincorporated areas only after approval of a referendum question on the subject by the majority of electors residing within the unincorporated areas of the Township; and

WHEREAS, a number of Township residents have been dissatisfied with the current methods of refuse collection and recycling within the Township; and

WHEREAS, refuse and recycling services to Milton Township residents has been inconsistent and has resulted in significant truck traffic on Township roads; and

WHEREAS, the Township Supervisor and Board are convinced that unified contractual refuse and recycling collection will provide a material benefit and cost savings to the Township and its unincorporated residents; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor and Board of Milton Township deem it advisable and in the best interests of the Township and its residents to place a referendum question on the Ballot of the March 19, 2024 General Primary Election to determine whether a majority of the unincorporated residents support authorizing the Township to contract for refuse, garbage and recycling services from a common vendor; and

WHEREAS, a referendum on the enhanced authorization to contract for refuse services may be placed on the Ballot by adoption of a resolution approving the referendum and timely filing of a certified copy of the resolution to the local election authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Supervisor and the Board of Trustees of Milton Township, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**Section 1:** That the Board hereby finds all the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are full, true and correct, and it shall incorporate them into this Resolution by reference.

**Section 2:** That the following proposition shall be placed on the Ballot and submitted to the unincorporated voters of Milton Township at the General Primary Election to be held on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2024 (the "Election"):

Shall Milton Township, DuPage County, Illinois be authorized to exercise the powers of the "Township Refuse Collection and Disposal Act" (60 ILCS 1/210-5 *et seq.*) to enter into a contract for the collection, disposal, composting and recycling of garbage and refuse for residents of the unincorporated areas of Milton Township?

**Section 3:** That the Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established by the Election Authority for DuPage County for all unincorporated voters of the Township at the Election.

**Section 4:** That the Election Authority for DuPage County shall give notice of the Election (the "Notice") in accordance with the general election law in the Election Code (10 ILCS 5/12-1 *et seq.*).

**Section 5:** That not less than 10 days before the date of the Election, the Township Clerk shall post a copy of the Notice at the principal office of the Township.

**Section 6:** That the Ballot to be used at the Election shall be in substantially the following form, with such alterations, changes, deletions and insertions as required by Articles 24A, 24B or 24C of the Code of Electronic Voting System is used at the Election:

**Section 8:** That the Township Clerk shall, not less than sixty-eight (68) days before the Election, certify to the Election Authority for DuPage County the proposition as hereinabove set forth to be submitted to the voters of the Township at the Election. Such certification shall include the form of the public question to be placed on the Ballot, the date on which the public question was initiated by the adoption of this Resolution, and a certified copy of the Resolution, and shall be substantially in the form attached hereto and hereby made a part of this Resolution.

**Section 9:** That the Election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in the manner and the time provided by law.

**Section 10:** That all resolutions and parts thereof in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this Resolution be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its adoption and approval.






