PURPOSE OF RESOLUTION NO. 1:

"RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CERTAIN POWERS TO THE BOARD"

This is a standard Resolution presented to the Electors every year. The Resolution covers miscellaneous and unusual situations which may come up during the year – if the Board cannot act in these situations, a Special Town Meeting must be held.

No changes to the Electors' powers are being proposed which would give the Board the authority to change tax rates, or to transfer money between funds not annually provided for in the Township Code and related laws without the authority of the Electors – these powers would be exercised by the Electors at a Town Meeting.

PURPOSE OF RESOLUTION NO. 2:

"FIXING HOUR FOR TOWNSHIP MEETINGS"

The Township Electors determine the hour for Annual and Special Township Meetings. This Resolution sets 7:00 p.m. as the hour to begin the Annual Meetings and 6:30 p.m. as the hour to begin the monthly Board Meetings and any Special Town Meetings during the next year.

PURPOSE OF RESOLUTION NO. 3:

"Resolution for Public Question on Transportation Services"

The Township Code and the Election Code authorize the Electors, at the Annual Town Meeting, to request an Adversary Question be placed on the Official Ballot. If the Electors at the Annual Town Meeting agree, the Town Board will submit to the Citizens of Milton Township the Question:

Shall the Township of Milton expand its transportation services to include all able-bodied people between the ages of 19 and 64?
