REGULAR MEETING OF THE MILTON TOWNSHIP COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH BOARD

President Hartnett took roll call, and all were present except Secretary Murphy.

President Hartnett led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment:

Jim Haptonstahl from UCP Seguin was in attendance to thank the board in person as they were not able to attend the meet and greet. He spoke about how the money was already being used and was incredibly grateful.

New Business:

The CMHB FY2025 budget was completed and submitted to the Milton Township Trustees for review. The Board briefly discussed the budget as well as the Financial Report for February. Going forward these reports will be attached to the minutes for review.

Manager Hutchins presented the 2023 Summary Report, and the board thought it was extremely helpful. The 2023 summary covered the first full year of funding. 6553 Milton Township residents were served by the funding partners in 2023.

Several Board Members were able to meet with their funding partners in the past month.

- Member Evans visited NAMI & City of Wheaton. She had a great visit with both partners. NAMI is collaborating with schools and City of Wheaton is collaborating with WPD social workers. The City of Wheaton was extremely excited because CMHB funding has allowed them to move from spreadsheets to case management software.
- Member Lyon visited ECFA and World Relief. World Relief will be having Spring Luncheon in April. Manager Hutchins will forward the event details to the board.
- President Harnett shared that she visited the UCP Seguin Day Center (on Carleton in Wheaton) and Group Home (CILA). She enjoyed the visit and learned a lot.

President Hartnett announced that The Milton Township Community Mental Health Board was the recipient of the 2023 Community Changemaker Award by the DuPage County Prevention Leadership Team (PLT). The Community Changemaker Award was awarded to Milton Township for its commitment to mental health and substance use prevention through its Mental Health Board. Milton Township's initiatives have positively influenced thousands of residents and set an example for other communities. President Hartnett and Manager Hutchins were in attendance to accept the award.


