President Hartnett called the meeting to order. Secretary Evans completed the roll call. President Hartnett led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment: None

Approval of Minutes of June 24, 2025, meeting. Motion to approve the minutes by Member Platt and seconded by Member Richman. All were in favor.

Funding Partner Presentations:

UCP Sequin of Greater Chicago – they believe that people, regardless of ability, deserve to achieve their potential, advance their independence and act as full members of the community. They provide life skills training, assistive technology, meaningful employment and a place to call home for people with disabilities. They place and support them in community jobs throughout the Greater Chicago area, including in our own social enterprises. They are helping thirteen Milton residents.

NAMI DuPage - NAMI DuPage supports and educates individuals and families affected by mental illness, working towards eliminating stigma and enhancing mental health within our community. They are helping 1548 residents, 1215 youth, 138 parents and 195 seniors. NAMI on campus at Wheaton North has been a great success. Strong leaders and five presentations with 75 people attending.

Teen Parent Connection – To serve the community through education on the realities and responsibilities of teenage pregnancy and through long-term assistance to adolescent parents for their development of self-esteem parenting skills, and empowerment towards self-sufficiency. They have childbirth education classes, new moms and new dads postpartum support group, feeding support group.

Old Business:

Motion to approve the Wheaton Library Social Worker Intern program. Member Brosnan made the motion. Member McCarthy Seconded. All were in favor and motion carried.

Board agreed to have Members Brosnan, Platt and Richman find out when library interns will start.

New Business:

President Hartnett reviewed June's financials. Member Evans made a motion to approve the financial report. Seconded by Member Richman. All were in favor. Motion passed.

Presidents report:

President Hartnett spoke about release of second payments. There were four funded partners whose second payment will be delayed pending further information. These include: NAMI DuPage, B.R. Ryall, CASE, and the DuPage County Health Department. Angie and board liaisons will follow up to obtain identified information and let Angie know when second checks can be released. President Hartnett and Secretary Evans will set up a meeting with the DCHD once the CRC opens to discuss payment options (lump sum vs. monthly invoicing based on utilization).

President Hartnett mentioned how much she enjoyed visiting Midwest Shelter for Homeless Veterans and learning more about their services.
